

CONSTITUTION OF THE
WESTERN POLITICAL SCIENCE ASSOCIATION

Salt Lake City, Utah, November 29, 1947

ARTICLE I - NAME AND PURPOSE

The name of this organization shall be the Western Political Science Association. The purpose of the organization shall be to promote the study and teaching of government, to foster research, to facilitate the discussion of public affairs; and, as a section thereof, to conform to the objects of the American Political Science Association. No action shall be taken in the name of the national association, as a section thereof, without the express authority of the Association.

ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the organization shall consist of any members of the American Political Science Association who desire to affiliate. Other members, including associate members, may be admitted under general rules or by action of the executive council.

ARTICLE III - OFFICERS

The officers of the organization shall consist of a president, a vice-president, a secretary-treasurer, and six councilors. The three officers and six councilors shall together comprise the executive council of the Association.

ARTICLE IV - ELECTIONS

The president and vice-president shall be elected by the members at the annual meeting of the Association for a term of one year. Councilors shall be elected for a term of two years, provided that at the first election held three councilors shall be elected for a term of one year. The secretary-treasurer shall be appointed by the executive council and shall serve at the pleasure of the council. Election shall be held at each annual meeting in a manner prescribed by the executive council, provided, that there shall be opportunity at such meetings for nominations from the floor before final election.

ARTICLE V - ANNUAL MEETING

The annual meeting of the Association shall be held during the Thanksgiving week end of each year, unless otherwise provided by the executive council.

ARTICLE VI - PROGRAM - POWERS OF OFFICERS

The program of the Western Political Science Association shall include opportunity for presentation of papers and scholarly discussion of matters pertinent to the field of political science and the development of additional features consistent with its name and purpose. The elected officers and members of the council shall have the right to carry on business consistent with the aims, purposes, and program of the Association, provided, that all recommendations involving membership dues, the rights and privileges of members, and the place and time of the annual meeting must receive the approval of the majority of those members present at each annual meeting.

ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENT

This constitution may be amended at any annual meeting by a majority vote of the ballots cast by those present and of those ballots returned by mail.
